 - No sevens season
 - Shortened Season
- 2020 1300 Total members
 - ► Fall Uncertainty
 - Conservative estimate for budgeting

2019-2020 Challenges

- Director of Finance voted out due to inability to fill the role - November
- Poor winter weather January/February
- COVID-19 March
- USAR Bankruptcy April and On-going
- 2020 2021 season planning On-going

Accomplishments

- Regained 501C3 status for union
 - Protect the board
 - Allow for donations and sponsors
- Free to all players and coaches registered with CGRU
 - Canterbury Crusaders Camp
 - > \$4350.00 Admin / Coaching / Player Development
- LA 7s invitational
 - Collegiate Women \$4063.85
 - ▶ Women \$4063.85
 - ▶ Men \$0.00 did not send team due to league schedule
- Increase visibility on Facebook and Instagram
- ▶ Got USAR to pay us the money they owed us
- Still here!

USAR update

- Bankruptcy is going okay, USAR will survive and is set up for future success
 - ► Hopeful for conclusion on September 1st
- New Competitions management system (CMS)
 - Kelly Ting to review
 - Send out trainings to you once we receive them
 - Hopefully by the end of the month
- Likely less dues to USAR, but offset by dues to the local union
 - ▶ USAR will provide less service, we pay for the services we want
 - Some services will be taken on by the Union, so we will need to fund those
 - Overall CIPP shouldn't meaningfully change for total amount
 - ▶ More money will be spent in the CGRU to benefit the CGRU
 - ▶ CGRU CIPP is one of the 3 lowest in the country
- Much smaller office, and money will be less likely to be co-mingled
- World Rugby Trans Guidelines USAR continues to collect feedback to give to World Rugby regarding new guidelines
- USAR Dues expected to be about \$37 per player and \$50 per team for Club Rugby, coaches and refs may be a little bit more. (These have not been set in stone)

Return to Play Guidelines

- North Carolina is in Stage 3 until at least September 11th
- South Carolina and Georgia are in Stage 4
 - ► Touch rugby scrimmaged allowed, no inter-squad competition
- Stage 5 is when we can go back to playing games
- ► CIPP insurance is "good" until the end of August
- ► Each team should purchase a non-touch thermometer and measure and record players temps before each practice.

Financial Update 2019-2020

- Balance as of 8/30/19 \$51,877
- New Revenue \$24,054.04
- Expenses \$18,977.69
- New Balance \$56,693.49
- Includes \$10,000 in a 6-month bond that we renewed (gained roughly \$200)
- 2019-2020 Budget: \$25,500 in dues, \$37,450 in expenses
 - Trying to use the money to grow the game
 - Discrepancy caused in that most our expenses are in the spring
- One-time expense in setting up 501C3

Finances for 2020-2021

- Principle:
 - ► Keep a rainy-day fund close to 6 months 1 year of operating expenses
 - Slowly draw down the excess by growing the game and offering unique opportunities to our teams and players
- Starting Balance: \$56,693.49
- Potential new expenses in budget
 - National Championships \$10,400
 - Part-time contractor \$7,800 (\$10 week, \$15/hr, 52 weeks a year)
 - > 3rd party accountant \$1000 (probably less)
- 2020-2021 Budget
 - Revenue \$48,100 (based on 1300 players at \$37 to the union, \$35+- USAR)
 - Expenses \$59,250
 - Net (\$11,150)
 - ► Ending Balance \$45,543 = 9 months of expenses
